Association, plaza gain manager

Maui-based Peake & Levoy has been named manager of the Maui Research & Technology Park Owners Association and of the Park Plaza.

The tech park in Kihei, developed in the early 1990s, includes five buildings totaling 180,000 square feet of lab, office and data center space. It is home to more than 20 high-tech and professional service companies, including Akimeka, Boeing and the Maui High Performance Computing Center.
